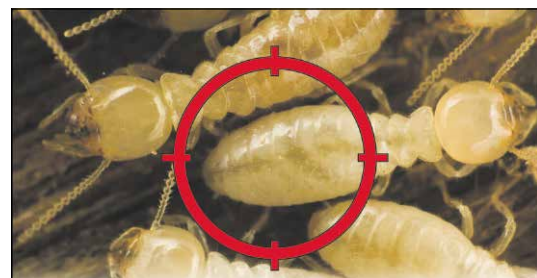

# The Louis-Constant Fleming Hospital Center regains its certification

Despite the turmoil that has recently shaken the hospital – between the orthopedic surgeon case and, more recently, the sanctions requested against the current director – progress seems to have been made, particularly thanks to the commitment of all staff. The establishment has thus regained its certification for the quality and safety of its care.

The certification process for healthcare facilities in France is overseen by the Haute Autorité de Santé (HAS). This independent procedure aims to evaluate the quality and safety of care provided to patients. It relies on visits conducted by external expert assessors mandated by the HAS, who analyze the organization of the facility, the practices of medical teams, and the care of patients. The Louis-Constant Fleming Hospital lost its certification in 2014. A new HAS certification visit took place in 2023, but highlighted significant deficiencies in several areas of quality and safety of care, requiring improvements: securing the medication circuit, particularly for high-risk medications, securing the management of critical emergencies, securing the management of immediate postpartum hemorrhage, ensuring

compliance with best practices regarding restrictive measures of liberty, working on patient information, continuing the implementation of differentiated reception for minor patients, developing evaluation processes for practices, and strengthening the quality and safety culture among professionals. A new certification visit has therefore been scheduled for 2025 to verify the implementation of corrective measures on these various points.

The certification commission of the Haute Autorité de Santé reviewed the file of the Marigot hospital again during its session on January 10 and, in light of the progress made, granted the facility certification. **A.B**



## Cybercrime



An American, suspected of stealing 46 million dollars in cryptocurrency, was arrested Wednesday evening in a residence on the French side of the island. The man, considered the main target in a cybercrime investigation, was apprehended during a joint operation conducted by the military of the GIGN (Guadeloupe branch of the National Gendarmerie Intervention Group) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). He has been placed in custody.

## Child Protection: what is the status of the investigation?

In September, the children entrusted to three foster caregivers, who had been under contract with the Community for several years, were taken away from them. They appealed to a lawyer, while the Community assigned the case to its legal department. Two versions are in opposition.

New planes highlighted the tense situation within the Child Welfare Service in our columns last December. To recall, in November, the service agents exercised their right to withdraw. This was the second right to withdraw exercised in 2025 within the same service. For foster families, the successive and persistent interruption of relationships between parents and placed children raises questions regarding the «best interests of the child» as guaranteed by the International Convention on the Rights of the Child. Indeed, maintaining personal relationships between a child and their family is a fundamental principle of child protection. However, tensions began on September 24, when the children entrusted to these foster families were taken from them during what was initially a routine meeting.

dated January 9, requested from the Community «transparent explanations regarding the situation, the reasons, and the framework of this withdrawal procedure» as well as the payment of unpaid salaries. The outstanding salaries for October, November, and December have been paid, but the January salary has been cut again.

Furthermore, they emphasize that no regulatory text provides for the existence of a one-month investigation procedure allowing for the withdrawal of children entrusted to a foster family without a formal decision, without prior information to the interested party, without a defined legal framework, and whose duration could be extended indefinitely without communication to the concerned agent. They have therefore sought the assistance of a lawyer specializing in administrative law, who submitted a compensation claim to the Community on February 3, as a formal notice in a final attempt at amicable resolution. In the absence of responses and concrete actions, they indicate that they will bring the matter before the administrative court.

### FOSTER FAMILIES HIRE A LAWYER

It was then indicated that an explanation would be provided within eight days. Ultimately, on October 2, they learned that the procedure was part of a one-month investigation – with no impact on their pay. They were assured that this was not a procedure for the withdrawal of approval. Five months after that infamous «meeting,» they indicate that they still have no information on the outcome of the procedure. They have therefore sought the assistance of a lawyer who, in a letter

### REPORTS THAT INITIATED THE INVESTIGATION

With the foster families having sought legal counsel, the case is now in the hands of the legal department of the Community. When questioned, it stated that the foster families had indeed been informed of the situation and that individual meetings had been organized with each of them. Furthermore, the Community confirms that an investigation was indeed initiated following reports from children under their care. The procedure was followed, and after these initial interviews, hearings were also conducted with professionals from the socio-educational sector outside the Community as part of the investigation. This investigation is now closed. The investigation report will soon be sent to the lawyers of the foster families, assures the Community.

However, given the particularly serious allegations of abuse, it specifies that if the facts were to be confirmed, it does not intend to stop there, considering the involvement of children. The procedure will therefore continue, and in light of the seriousness of the alleged facts, a report under Article 40 may be considered. Regarding the service, the Community assures that the agents have resumed work since February 12 and that its operation has now been restored. **A.B**

# The CCISM now at home

The signing, on Thursday morning, of an agreement formalizing the principle agreement for the transfer of the CCISM building from the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of Guadeloupe to the Collectivity of Saint Martin marks an important step for the local economy. More than just an administrative act, this agreement symbolizes the opening of a new phase of cooperation between the institutions, after several years of disagreement over the ownership of the House of Enterprises.

Situated at 10 Jean-Jacques Fayel Street in Concordia, the building that houses the House of Enterprises – CCISM serves as a central location for supporting entrepreneurs in the area. However, its land situation had long remained unresolved.

## A FILE RELATED TO AUTONOMY

BEFORE SAINT-Martin attained the status of an overseas collectivity in 2007, the consular activity of the territory depended on the Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCI) of Guadeloupe, which had a local branch established in the House of Enterprises in Concordia. The land and the building therefore belonged to the Guadeloupean consular chamber. In 2009, a document was reportedly signed between the president of the CCI of Basse-Terre — prior to the merger of the Guadeloupean CCIs — and the president of the Territorial Council of Saint-Martin. This document provided for the free transfer of the land and the building to the Collectivity, in line with the new institutional organization: Saint-Martin, having become an overseas collectivity, was to gradually regain its economic tools. In 2010, the CCI of the Islands of Guadeloupe ultimately sold the building to the Collectivity for €350,000. A few years later, under the administration of Aline Hanson, the Collectivity contested this sale, arguing that the initial agreement provided for a free transfer. It then initiated legal proceedings to obtain a

refund of the amount paid. The signature that took place Thursday morning now aims to definitively clarify the situation. The principle agreement regarding the building was signed between the Collectivity, represented by its 4th vice-president Michel Petit, and the CCI of the Islands of Guadeloupe, represented by its president Patrik Vial-Collet, in the presence of CCISM president Angèle Dormoy, Deputy Frantz Gumbs, Prefect Cyrille Le Vély, and CCI France president Alain Di Crescenzo. For the participants, this agreement marks the culmination of long-standing work and opens a new chapter for this strategic location in the economic life of the territory. The goal is to strengthen support for entrepreneurs and to bolster the dynamism of the local economic fabric. Prior to this signature, a meeting with economic stakeholders, including MEDDEF and the Federation of Small Enterprises, allowed the president of CCI France to better understand the realities, challenges, and opportunities of the Saint-Martin economy in order to voice the territory's concerns at the national level. All speakers emphasized the necessity of working together to support local businesses. "The time for division is over," they stressed, reminding that many businesses are currently facing difficulties and that swift actions must be implemented.

Alain Di Crescenzo's visit, the third to the territory, was also an opportunity to discuss the upcoming Overseas CCI Conference, scheduled before the end of summer, as well as the common priorities for the eleven affected territories. Stay tuned for our Tuesday edition. **A.B**

# Visit of Naïma Moutchou

The Minister of Overseas Territories, Naïma Moutchou, will make her first official visit to the territory from March 8 to 10. She will also visit Saint Barthélemy.

During this trip, the minister will meet with the Presidents of the two Collectivities, representatives of institutions and state services, as well as economic, social, and associative actors to address the issues and perspectives of the two territories. She is also expected to sign the agreement between France and the Netherlands regarding the right of pursuit at sea in the waters of Saint Martin.

This provision is intended to allow French and Dutch security forces to pursue a vessel or a suspect beyond their maritime zone when an



offense is observed, particularly in the areas of combating trafficking or illegal immigration. **A.B**

# Air Antilles : decision postponed to April 2

On Thursday, March 5, the mixed commercial court of Pointe-à-Pitre granted an extension to the investor Pierre Sainte-Luce, the sole potential buyer of the company, to clarify and strengthen his recovery plan. The decision is now expected on April 2.

The tribunal found that the case had significant advancements compared to the first version, but still required adjustments. According to several sources, Pierre Sainte-Luce is considering refocusing Air Antilles' operations on the route between Guadeloupe and Saint-Martin, prioritizing the accessibility of the Northern islands, but is also contemplating developing services to the greater Caribbean, particularly Haiti, through a partnership with a regional airline. In this configuration, some current routes could disap-

pear. Furthermore, the 114 employees would not have the guarantee of keeping their jobs.

Financially, the offer also needs to be solidified, as the guarantee is far from the €10 million estimated necessary by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation to restart operations. The tribunal will make its decision on April 2. Until then, the investor must convince of the strength and viability of their project... and the planes will remain grounded. **A.B**

# The number of the month



According to the latest data from the Territorial Institute of Statistics and Economic Studies of Saint Martin (ITSEE), 1,361 businesses were created in the territory in 2025, of which 52% were sole proprietorships (micro-entrepreneurs, EURL, SASU). This represents a significant increase of 6% compared to the previous year and the highest number of business creations recorded since 2016. However, according to socio-professional institutions, this figure should be moderated, as while sole proprietorships are flourishing, the majority of PME and PMI are in difficulty.

# Annoyed by the noise, he takes out his rifle

The Marigot court examined on February 26 a case of armed violence: a man, disturbed by work at his neighbors' house, had chosen to confront them one Sunday, shotgun against his chest.

**O**n December 21, 2025, F.M., his wife, and their son are busy in two apartments they own. The noise disturbs R.M., their neighbor, who lives and works on-site as the property manager. He steps out of his home and approaches them shirtless, with a long gun pressed against his chest. In front of the couple's astonishment, he points the rifle in the air and pulls the trigger without any shot being fired. A gesture described by the defendant as a demonstration of safety. He then returns to his home to put down the weapon, before attempting to come back to talk. The neighbors, in shock, refuse any exchange. The next day, F.M. files a complaint. The medical-legal unit recognizes him as having reactionary anxiety. A search at the defendant's home leads to the seizure of a legally held arsenal: five long guns, two handguns, and ammunition.

## THE INTENTION AT THE HEART OF THE DEBATES

AT THE STAND, R.M. ADMITS TO A «misjudgment.» Holder of a sports shooting and trap shooting license, he claims he was cleaning his weapon at the time when the noise disturbances prompted him to intervene. His daughter was sleeping in the apartment, and he did not want to leave the weapon within her reach. «I have been handling firearms since I was sixteen; I didn't realize right away that it was a mistake to go out with it,» he explained, emphasizing his usual good relations with the plaintiffs. An argument that the civil parties' lawyer vigorously refuted, arguing that it was a deliberate act intended to intimidate his neighbors. «Whether the cartridge was blank or not does not change what the victims felt,» she argued. The deputy prosecutor

supported this view, highlighting the incongruity of the defense: a man who claims to be an expert in handling firearms cannot invoke inadvertence.

## ACQUITTAL OR CONVICTION: THE COURT WILL DECIDE ON MARCH 5

The public prosecutor has requested one year of imprisonment with a suspended sentence, the confiscation of the entire seized arsenal, and a ten-year prohibition on owning or carrying firearms. «Weapons are not toys. This is how tragedies happen,» the prosecution reminded. The civil parties are seeking €2,000 for moral damages for F.M. and €1,500 each for his wife and their son, plus an additional €1,500 per victim for procedural costs. The defense, for its part, argued for acquittal, contesting both the material element — as the weapon was never aimed at anyone — and the criminal intent, claiming that the «false shot» was solely aimed at reassuring. The lawyer also noted that the wife and son of the couple had explicitly refused to be examined by a doctor during their hearing, stating they did not feel the need — an element he deemed likely to weaken the demonstration of emotional shock constitutive of the offense. The court rendered its decision on March 5. Retaining the facts of violence with a threat of a weapon that did not result in a total incapacity for work exceeding eight days, it found R.M. guilty and sentenced him to six months of imprisonment with a suspended sentence. The court also prohibited him from owning or carrying a weapon for three years and ordered the confiscation of all seized weapons. In civil matters, each of the three civil parties was awarded €500 in compensation for moral damages, as well as €700 under Article 475 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

# A suspicious accident reclassified as double homicide

In Philipsburg, a road accident that occurred on the night of Monday, March 2, is now the subject of a criminal investigation. The Sint Maarten police (KPSM) announced that the incident, initially reported as an accident, is now being treated as a double homicide.



**S**hortly after 3:30 AM, law enforcement found an overturned SUV near the entrance of Arlet Peters Road, also known as Old Cake House Road. Inside the vehicle, the driver and a passenger were unconscious. Despite the intervention of emergency services, both occupants were pronounced dead at the scene. The initial findings by the police revealed elements suggesting that this was not a simple accident, and the investigation has therefore been assigned to the criminal brigade. According to the Daily Herald, the driver is known to law enforcement, while the passenger is reported to be an American tourist visiting the island. The Sint Maarten police are calling on anyone with information to come forward.

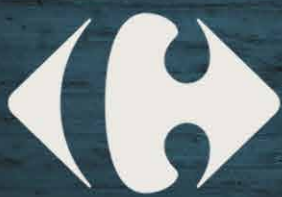

## Miss Saint-Martin-Saint-Barthélemy : who will be the chosen one?

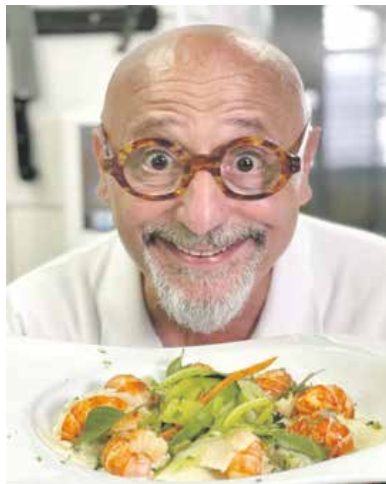

For the record, the Chococarib' fair will take place from March 14 to 16 at the Anse Marcel Beach Hotel.

# For as long as anyone can remember, the landscapes, the inhabitants, and the colors of Saint Martin have inspired the island's painters

Not everyone is famous, but they exist, and we have met a few of them to introduce you to over the coming weeks.

At the moment Francis Eck is about to leave the territory, Sir Roland Richardson has decided to stay, but he is not the only one wielding a paintbrush on both sides of the border. Indeed, painters have been part of the Saint Martin artistic scene for many years, such as the watercolorist Imé-Jahina "Chris" Ladéon, a Martinican who arrived here 30 years ago and now splits her time between the Friendly Island and Guadeloupe. For fans of typically Caribbean paintings, her name is not unknown as she was the creator of an art gallery (now gone) on the Savane road; she now exhibits in two renowned galleries in Simpson Bay: "Art & Gift" and "Art Box Gallery." Imé-Jahina is somewhat her artist name in homage to her African roots, but the use of "Chris" is more common to refer to her, whose talent is now recognized by connoisseurs, as it has not always been this way.

Moreover, it is not uncommon for admirers to express their emotions upon discovering a painting representing one of these old Caribbean homes similar to the one in which they lived with their parents or family.

But she is not the type to rest on her laurels, so she has decided to add a few tubes to her palette by indulging in the luxury of exploring the field of writing with a book currently in preparation. She has also recently taken up illustration techniques to enhance her texts with images straight from her imagination. The least one can say is that once again, the legend that artists are not inclined to work hard is contradicted by the evident fact that one of them does not waste her time. In addition to the aforementioned places, Imé-Jahina "Chris" Ladéon exhibits in Guadeloupe and occasionally in Saint Martin. To get a precise idea of her talent, we recommend checking out her Instagram page: Iméjahina\_art\_studio.

## PAINTING LIFE, WHAT COULD BE MORE BEAUTIFUL?

Watercolor allows for a wide range of colors, and while Chris is herself a great admirer of 18th and 19th-century painting, she readily admits that for the past 12 years, dedicating most of her time to this lighter art has allowed her to have a more serene and

Indeed, unlike most people who engage in artistic activities, she did not receive any graphic education as a child and does not remember having a taste for painting when she was young. It was following a life accident that she became interested in it, tried her hand at it, and had the revelation that changed her life. After experimenting with acrylics and pastels, she ultimately chose watercolor, which has become her preferred medium, although she sometimes allows herself a few diversions by working with wood in particular. For inspiration, nothing could be simpler: Chris observes the environment in which she lives, and it is enough for her to reproduce that while adding her personal touch, her interpretation, and her whimsy. Nature, and more specifically flowers, play a significant role in her universe, as do traditional Creole houses that mean a lot to her and evoke childhood memories when she brings them to life under the gentle caress of her brush.

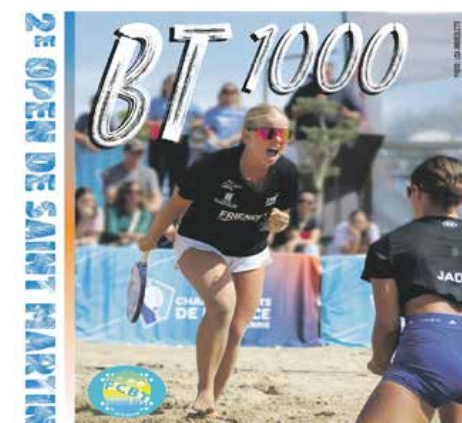
