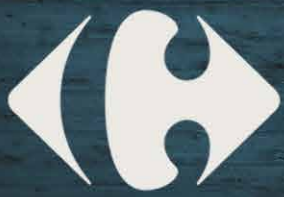

What is Europe doing for Saint Martin?

Since 2010, Europe has been celebrated in May throughout France, in order to honor the European Union and the thousands of projects it supports each year. 592 events are listed this year in the Hexagon. In Saint-Martin, a morning of celebration and exchanges is scheduled for this Saturday, May 9.

Since the month of May is dedicated to highlighting the actions of the European Union, Saturday, May 9, serves as the climax of the celebrations with Europe Day, which was created 40 years ago. This 2026 edition also marks the 40th anniversary of the use of the blue starry flag and the European anthem. It is also the 40th anniversary of Spain and Portugal's accession to the European Union. Therefore, this year, the day will be celebrated throughout France, as well as in the territory, under the sign of continuity and European values.

At the initiative of the Prefecture, a citizen meeting, open to all, will be organized this Saturday, May 9, from 9 AM to 12 PM at

the Soualiga College in La Savane. The goal is to highlight the many links that unite Saint Martin to the European Union, but also to allow exchanges «between citizens of a member country of the European Union.»

On the agenda for the morning: testimonies from project leaders in the territory on the question «What is Europe doing for Saint Martin?», activities on the theme, a traditional breakfast, the unveiling of a mural on the European Union and Saint Martin created within the college.

Information spaces on the European Union, as well as on the European funds that the territory may be eligible for, will also welcome the public. **A.B**

Citizenship Day: real encounters

A day to address fundamental questions such as the rights and duties of citizens, understanding the role of administrative or judicial authorities, or the integration of Saint Martin into the European Union is a bit short. But on Tuesday, as part of the Languages, Arts, and Culture Festival, speakers, middle school students, and high school students were able to optimize the exchanges, which were enriching and very informative.

Lectures with a young audience are often tedious and soporific, but that was not the case last Tuesday at the Grand Case Beach Club. The assembly was not only attentive but also very eager to learn more about the topics discussed. It is true that facing them were speakers, whom they are rarely confronted with, that sparked their curiosity. Prefect Cyrille Le Vely, Deputy Prosecutor Marie-Lucie Godard, Gendarmerie Commander Hugues Loyez, Vice-Rector Harry Christophe, Director of France Victimes Olivier Fatou, and Director of the Maison des Femmes Cibel Aydin engaged in a question-and-answer session that led to very enriching exchanges. Their professional backgrounds, their roles, and their missions not only interested the approximately 80 students present, but it was especially the way of practicing these different professions, while respecting the right balance between rights and duties, that was at the center of their questions. In the second part of the morning, the issues of today's society – pollution, climate change, water scarcity – were addressed in the same manner.

The discussions continued during lunch, in a very intelligent format since each speaker and a representative from an institution were at the table with the students.

Given current events, the afternoon was dedicated to a presentation of Europe by Sub-Prefect Marie-Hildgarde Chauveau with a particular focus on the implications this has for the territory.

France Work at the Women's House

On May 5th, the first session of France Travail took place at the Maison des Femmes de Marigot. This initiative aims to support women victims of violence in their gradual return to employment.

On March 29, a convention was signed between France Travail and the Maison des Femmes, a first in the territory. As part of this partnership, every first Monday of the month, work psychologist Chantal Hyman will meet with beneficiaries who wish to return to professional activity. "Our goal is the reintegration of these women into the workforce. To achieve this, we take into account the barriers they may have and the different types of violence they may have experienced," explains the professional. Originally from Saint-Martin and employed since 2019 at France Travail, Chantal Hyman is well aware of local realities. Her intervention is part of a comprehensive follow-up for women victims. Prior to this, beneficiaries receive psychological support to help them rebuild.

A DOOR TO THE FUTURE

The first beneficiary, Marianne*, explains her expectations regarding this new initiative. "I believe that a work psychologist has a much broader perspective and understanding of the situation I may have found myself in. This is not someone who will judge me," she shares. Beyond access to employment, it is a true rebir-

th that is taking place. "I work on exploring the journey, finding connections between what she wants to do and what is in her history," details the psychologist. This initiative illustrates a desire to bring employment services closer to the most vulnerable populations. For this launch, nine women will be supported in May. *Marianne, the name has been changed to ensure the anonymity of this person **L.G**

The airline Air Caraïbes presents its new long-haul aircraft model, the Airbus A350-900. A plane that will be deployed on the route connecting Paris-Orly to Princess Juliana Airport in Sint Maarten starting October 15, 2026.
